This wine is sourced from premium wine regions across south east Australia.

Vintage Conditions

2006 was a relatively early vintage, with low rainfall and warm weather contributing to an early budburst and flowering. Mild to warm weather throughout summer helped the fruit to mature well and rains at harvest allowed fruit to ripen well with good varietal character.

Colour

Bright crimson red with ruby highlights.



Nose

Red and black berry aromas merge with touches of spice, vanilla and more chocolatey, earthy notes.



Palate

A soft and elegant, medium bodied Merlot with delicious red berry flavours that are supported by darker, earthier tones. Maturation with oak adds a creamy, almost nutty complexity to the long, soft finish.
