Vintage Conditions

2006 was a relatively early vintage, with low rainfall and warm weather contributing to an early budburst and flowering. Mild to warm weather throughout summer helped the fruit to mature well and rains at harvest allowed fruit to ripen well with good varietal character.

Colour

Plum with crimson highlights.



Nose

Dark fruit aromas: cassis; mulberry; and plum, blend seamlessly with cedar-like spice and hints of creamy vanilla.



Palate

A medium to full bodied Shiraz, packed with intense plum flavours, touches of dark chocolate and spice. Creamy vanilla flavours frame the long, elegant finish.
