Viticulture

This wine comes from a mixture of vineyards across the South Eastern region of Australia. The 2007 summer ripening period was mild and fruit ripened steadily. At harvest the vineyards delivered balanced acid and sugar ripeness resulting in a wine with optimum flavour, distinct varietal characters and good natural acidity.

Winemaker's Comments

The 2007 shiraz is a lovely wine with great depth of flavour. Delightful strawberry, vanilla, white pepper and spice aromas lead to berry fruit flavours with a touch of lingering French oak on the palate. Soft tannins and balanced acid make this a medium to full bodied easy drinking wine.
